- To encourage a culture of research among teachers and students.
- To recommend modifications to the study to raise the standard of research
- To support the institute's integrative, trans-disciplinary, and evidence-based research

ACTIVITIES

- Reviewing research proposals to ensure compliance with ethical principles and regulatory standards.
- Evaluating the risks and benefits associated with research involving human participants.
- Assessing the informed consent process to ensure participants' understanding and voluntary participation.

- Monitoring ongoing research to ensure adherence to approved protocols and ethical guidelines.
- Investigating and addressing any ethical concerns or breaches that arise during the research process.
- Providing guidance and training to researchers on ethical principles and best practices.
- Collaborating with institutional authorities and regulatory bodies to ensure oversight and compliance.
- Educating the research community and the public about ethical considerations in research involving human subjects.
- Continuously updating policies and procedures to reflect evolving ethical standards and emerging ethical challenges.
- Promoting transparency and accountability in research by maintaining records and documentation of ethical review processes.
