1. Immediate Planning: (within 1 year)

2. Intermediate planning: (within 3 years)

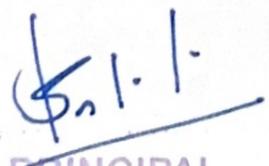
- **Establish Partnerships and MoUs with Healthcare Institutions** to provide enhanced clinical training opportunities, expand practical learning experiences for students.

- **Secure Research Grants from Management** to support faculty and student research projects, promoting a culture of inquiry and innovation.

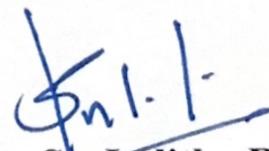
- **Implement Strategies to Reduce Staff Attrition Rates** by enhancing job satisfaction, professional development, and retention initiatives.
