- Collect feedback from recruiters and students to improve training programs and placement processes.



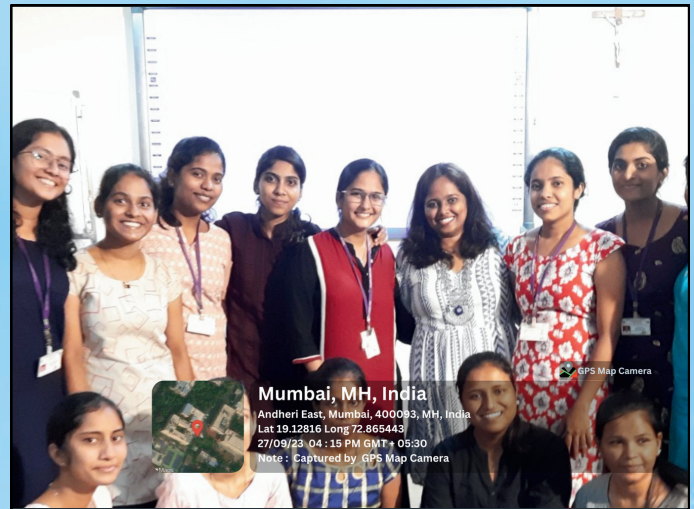
